Project DYNAMO is a veteran-led, donor-funded 501(c)(3) international rescue organization who rescues Americans, allies, and vulnerable civilians from warzones and dangerous situations across the globe.

BACKGROUND

Project DYNAMO is comprised of combat veterans and civilian volunteers working on the front lines, and beyond, to rescue Americans, NATO allies and other vulnerable civilians safely out of hostile territory. Using over two centuries worth of combined military, special operations, and intelligence experience, Project DYNAMO has rescued more than 6,000 people from conflict zones around the world — operating where the U.S. government is unwilling or unable to operate.

LEADERSHIP









Project DYNAMO is led by Bryan Stern, a multi-tour combat veteran of the U.S. Army and Navy who has conducted hundreds of small to large scale operations in over 60 countries.

Stern has more than 27 years of intelligence and special operations experience focused on Hostage Rescue, Counter-Terrorism, Counter-Proliferation, Critical Technology Protection, Sensitive Activities, Foreign Materiel Acquisition, Unconventional Warfare, and discretionary operations in contested or denied areas.


Bryan is a leading expert in transnational threats, Great Power Competition, conducting operations in denied areas, and the design and execution of non-standard rescue missions. He specializes in developing human and physical infrastructure in contested areas, conflict zones, and denied areas.

Stern is a Purple Heart recipient and has been recognized on numerous occasions by the U.S. Secretary of Defense, Secretary of the Army, Chief of U.S. Army Infantry, and Director of the Defense Intelligence Agency, and others. Stern was also a military first responder on the morning of September 11th in New York City.

Stern is a frequent contributor to international media, U.S. and allied governments, academia, as well as the commercial and financial sectors, addressing difficult problems and geopolitical crisis.

Project DYNAMO is credited with more rescues of American citizens from denied-areas than any other Governmental or Non-Governmental Organization in the world.

AFGHANISTAN- ONGOING

OPERATIONS:

NOMAD (land) & SLINGSHOT (air)

FOCUS:

- American Citizens left behind after the fall of Kabul to the Taliban.
- Lawful Permanent Residents (LPRs) of U.S.
 Citizens of NATO-allied countries.
- Afghan allies who fought with us and are now hunted by Taliban (commandos, NDS, women's rights activists, sources).

GROUND & AIR TRANSPORTATION:

- More than 275 rescue missions via land and air from August 2021 to present day.
- Landed first aircraft in Kabul after Taliban took control in Sep 2021, successfully evacuating 117 American Citizens in a single day.
- DYNAMO was and remains boots-on-ground.

OPERATIONS: **UKRAINE - ONGOING**

RESCUED SO FAR:

- More than 3,000 rescued & exfiltrated from war-zone and Russian occupied areas.
- · Over 20 different nationalities citizens evacuated.
- Focused on the most vulnerable populations needing help in the hardest-hit conflict areas on the front lines and beyond.

OPERATION: PATHFINDER (RUSSIA)

- First "kinetic" rescue of Americans INSIDE Russia in U.S. - Russian history
- Front page Moscow Times. Putin called Duma to emergency session as a result of PATHFINDER.

MISSIONS:

- 300+ missions completed throughout occupied areas.
- Buses, cars, ambulances, jet skis, and boats throughout hostile territory amid attacks by Russian forces targeting civilians and Americans.
- Many specialty missions: evacuating premature & newborn American babies, blind/deaf, Holocaust Survivors, MEDEVAC, pets, and many more.

ORION (special ops & hostages):

- Unilateral daring hostage rescues of Americans unlawfully detained and tortured by Russian Security Services.
- 12 operations to date.

HOME FRONT
(Hurricane lan)

HIGHLIGHTS:

- Executed dangerous rescue operations in war-zone like conditions via sea, air, and land.
- Credited with being "first in the water," first on Sanibel Island, & first maritime rescue the morning of Day 1 of the Hurricane Ian.
- Evacuated more than 70 stranded civilians via boat and air cutoff from South Florida mainland during Hurricane Ian.
- Landed U.S. Coast Guard helicopters on the beach for critical MEDEVAC care – elderly evacuees - in cardiac crisis.
- Rescued amputees, pets, children, & others from islands.
- Operation: NOAHS ARK rescued over 200 endangered birds
 & primates by boat.

Sudan - ONGOING OPERATION: RHINO RIVER

TO DATE:


- U.S. special forces evacuated embassy and staff, leaving thousands of American Citizens stranded.
- DYNAMO rescued 140 Americans with more than half being children.
- Complex evacuations through war-torn Sudan using intelligence tradecraft and sensitive methods.
- Provided non-standard ground and air rescue support for Americans trapped in Sudan, including transportation, housing, checkpoints, and food, with zero USG assistance.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- First and only aircraft to rescue Americans and first charter aircraft used in the war.
- 86 Americans evacuated in one day to Egypt via 13-hour ground movement and complex air exfil.
- DYNAMO was the sole American aircraft operating for rescues in the country for weeks.
- Conducted multiple special operations via land for Americans in extreme peril, including Operation: COFFEE BEAN and others.
